

# MEMBERSHIP POLICY

1. Junior Club is a membership organisation.
2. Membership will be offered to children living in Tilehurst.
3. Guests may attend at the discretion of the Co-ordinator. They will be signed in by a member.
4. Applications for membership will be considered from young people in school years 4, 5, 6 and 7.
5. Applications from young people outside the Junior Club age range will be referred to Reading Borough Council's Area Youth & Community Officer.
6. Attendance ceiling for Activity nights is 100 and for Disco's 150. No child will be admitted once the attendance ceiling has been reached. These limits may be reduced at the discretion of the co-ordinator.
7. Annual Subscriptions are due on 1st September each year.
8. The level of annual subscriptions and nightly charges will be determined by the Junior Club Management Committee.
9. When young people have completed their 7th year at school their membership will cease and they will be referred to Reading Borough Council's Area Youth & Community Officer.
10. Membership may be suspended or withdrawn if any young person behaves in a violent or socially unacceptable manner, breaks Club rules, contravenes the Junior Youth Club's Health & Safety regulations, or that puts staff / members or visitors at risk.
11. The club is open from 7pm to 9.30pm each Friday evening.
12. Parents / Guardians are responsible for ensuring that their children arrive and are collected safely at the end of each Club session. We strongly recommend that Parents / Guardians collect their children from inside the youth club. The door will normally be open from 9.15pm. (Parents / Guardians wishing to collect their children before 9.15pm should ring the front door bell). No child will be allowed to leave the premises until the end of a Club session unless they are collected by a parent.
13. The membership will comprise of maximum of 175 young people. When the membership is full, a waiting list will be introduced.
14. It is the responsibility of Parents / Guardians to ensure that their child can be admitted.
15. It is the responsibility of Parents / Guardians to ensure that they can be contacted in an emergency.
16. All matters concerning the Junior Club Membership Policy are at the discretion of the co-ordinator. Appeals may be made to the Junior Club Management Committee.
17. The Junior Club Management Committee cannot be responsible for replacing lost or damaged items. Money must not be left in coats / bags that are unattended. No valuables should be brought onto the premises.
