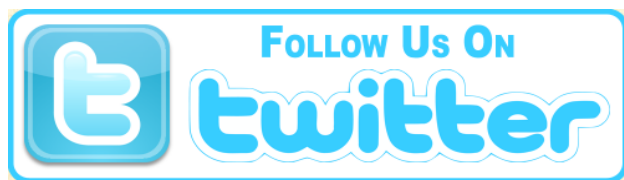
Jungle Evening

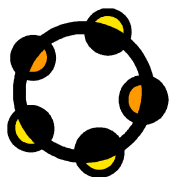
At particular times, often with only a couple of days notice donations will be matched pound for pound by various benefactors.



Please help us to get the word out so we can secure donors which will enable staff to spend less time fundraising and more time organising activities.

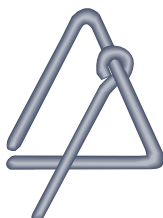
Making Musical Instruments
